

Primary Objective of the Position:

The HR Manager role is full-time position based in Hamilton, Ontario. It is a hands-on position that will work closely with the supervisors, management and staff to provide day-to-day HR operations support for approximately 300 employees. Your success will be to provide real time advice and thoughtful guidance by exercising excellent judgement, problem solving and decision making skills and ensuring compliance with policies, processes and legislation. Reporting to the Head of HR.

Essential Position Functions:

Location: Oversee the HR function at the Hamilton base location (near the Hamilton airport)

Hours: This role is primarily evening and night shifts to support the staff.
Ideally, Mon & Wed & Thurs (5pm to 1am) and Tues & Fri (11am-7pm). Some flexibility will be required.

- Responsible for handling all complex employee relations issues and progressive discipline with a high level of confidence and comfort for staff and management levels and ensuring timely resolution.
- Providing guidance and advice in accordance compliance, process and legislative requirements.
- Working closely with the Head of HR and the HR team at Head office
- Collaborate with base manager and supervisors to investigate and address issues and processes while ensuring consistency when providing recommendations.
- Promote and environment of open, honest communication between management and staff. Facilitate conversations as required.
- Handle all end to end recruitment functions (including job fairs and outreach efforts)
- Facilitate and assist with injury, STD and LTD as well as return to work plans procedures
- Coordinate various reporting and keep appropriate documentation for all areas
- Handle all paperwork for staff changes and new hires
- Facilitate onboarding for new hires and coordinate any training needs as required
- Proactively enforce all company policies and procedures in adherence to corporate and legislative requirements.
- Coordinate any health and safety requirements and participate on JHSC to ensure consistency
- Assist with research, analysis and implementation of projects as required
- Work closely with the Head of HR and regularly liaise with head office HR department and staff
- Other related duties and responsibilities as required

- Must hold a CHRL or equivalent with an educational background in Human Resources or Labour relations
- Experience in the aviation, transpiration or logistics work environment is an asset
- Strong investigation, negotiation and analytical skills
- Excellent knowledge of Employment Standards, AODA, Health and Safety and other related legislation.

- Ability to identify and implement high quality HR best practices
- Proven record for conflict resolution
