As Cargojet continues to grow and prosper we strive to exceed our high standards of aircraft Technical Dispatch, Fleet Reliability and On-Time Performance for our customers. With the growth and acquisition of newer generation aircraft we have expanded our capabilities in Maintenance & Engineering.

Engineering - Capacity and Cost Focused

The Engineering Team provides technical expertise for aircraft fleet acquisitions, engineering, power plant and heavy maintenance. Glenn Simard the Vice President of Heavy Maintenance and Fleet Acquisition leads the Team in analyzing fleet performance and introducing reliability enhancements and incorporation of airframe and engine modifications to improve our maintenance program and fleet reliability. Working with the aircraft and engine manufacturers as well our MRO vendors for power plant and heavy maintenance, we look for opportunities to control costs and improve fleet performance. In order to meet our customers' demands, new aircraft are evaluated and sourced to provide Cargojet with the required additional aircraft capacity.



Line Maintenance & Maintenance Control -Operational Performance

As Cargojet grows across the network and expand to new destinations through schedule and charter growth, we have aligned our organizational leadership to be regionally focused. Leading the Line Maintenance Team, Leo Cordeiro is the Vice President of Line Maintenance bringing 31 years of aviation technical operations experience in Maintenance Control, Line and Hangar Maintenance. Leading the Supply Chain Team, Larry O'Brien is the Director of Technical Purchasing & Supply Chain and is responsible for purchasing & material control, rotable and repair system, inventory, tool calibration control system, shelf life control system and negotiating pooling and loan/borrow agreements. The Supply Chain Team strives to deliver value by improving efficiency, control costs and mitigate risks in support of Cargojet's operations.

Proactive Initiatives

The weekly fleet readiness program is a proactive initiative where maintenance actively prepares the aircraft for an on-time departure by completing aircraft and engine system functions including engine runs and 'mock' departures. The 'mock' departure has maintenance operating cargo doors, loading systems, APU starts while checking for faults and resolving them before the actual freight loading and departure commences.



Collaboratively, the maintenance Team's mandate is a proactive approach to Technical Dispatch, Reliability and On-Time Performance for our customers.


