








How to Draw a Snowman

THE GRINCH PUNCH

This colorful Grinch Punch is the perfect drink for the Christmas season. It is such a fun idea and kids love it, you can whip it up for your holiday party, cozy How The Grinch Stole Christmas movie nights, and even just for yourself if you feel like it. What you'll need

Pineapple juice – or use orange juice instead, Make sure the fruit juice that you use is smooth and does not have bits in it. **Sprite** – or you can use lemon lime soda or lemonade.

Lemonade concentrate – use your favorite brand.

Kool Aid – You need kool aid that is green color. I used liquid Kool-aid, but you can easily used the crystal kind –some flavors are lemon lime Kool aid. Just make sure to follow the instructions on the packet for proportions of kool aid and water.

Tap water – to help dilute the green kool-aid.

How you'll make it!

Gently stir together sprite, water, lemonade concentrate, pineapple juice, and Kool-Aid in a large pitcher.

Dip the glass rims in water (or sugar syrup or cont syrup) and then into the sanding sugar to coat them.
