On behalf of our Board of Directors, and all Management Team, we sincerely wish each of you and your families a safe, healthy, and Happy Holiday season and the very best in 2024!












A MESSAGE FROM OUR CO-CEO'S


STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM...

Popsicle Stick Airplane Ornament



For each airplane, you will need 2 large craft sticks, 3 small craft sticks, one clothespin, and one wood bead.

Paint the craft sticks and let them dry completely. Assemble the airplane as show in these pictures:

Attach the craft stick wings to the bottom side of the clothespin, then another set of wings on the top side of the clothespin. Add the last small craft stick to the front of the clothespin (it's the propeller) and glue the wood bead into place right in the center. This part really does need to be done with hot glue or else it falls off too easily. Hot glue a loop of twine to the clothespin. The loop will be used to hang the ornament from the tree. Print out a picture onto heavyweight cardstock or photo paper and cut it out. You'll want the photo to be about 1 inch. Glue the photo in between the wings. And that's it! You're done!

Now you have a cute, whimsical, sentimental ornament you will treasure for years to come!

Holiday Crunch Popcorn





Step 1: You will need 10 cups of popcorn.

Step 2: After the popcorn is popped, make sure to remove all of the un-popped kernels. You don't want to bite down on one of those!

Step 3: Once you have made the popcorn, salt it liberally. It is so nice to taste the salty popcorn with the sweet marshmallow coating.

Step 4: To make the Marshmallow Mixture, add 3 tablespoons of butter to a medium saucepan. Melt the butter on medium heat, stirring occasionally until the butter is completely melted.

Step 5: Add 3 cups of mini marshmallows to the saucepan.

Step 6: Stir until the marshmallows are covered in butter, and then continue to stir until the marshmallows are completely melted.

Step 7: Take the marshmallow mixture off the heat as soon as the last marshmallow has melted.

Step 8: Now pour the popcorn onto a cookie sheet covered with parchment paper.

Step 9: Use the spatula to even the popcorn out on the cookie sheet.

Step 10: Now it is time for the candy mix-ins, mix evenly to the popcorn.

Step 11: Allow the Holiday Crunch Popcorn to cool. Break apart into pieces and serve.
