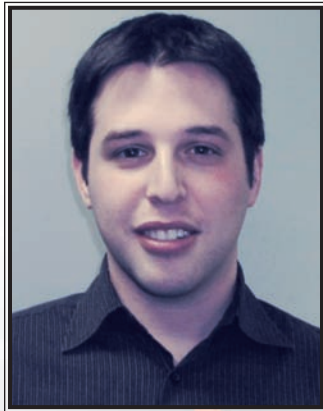

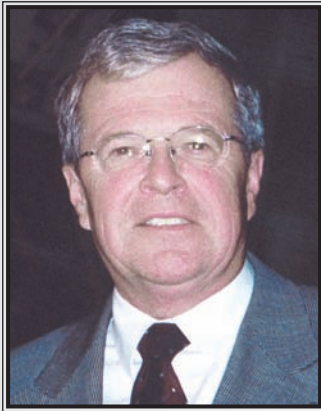
I hope to participate in many more walks to help find a cure for this disease and I hope to be able to count on all of you again this time next year.

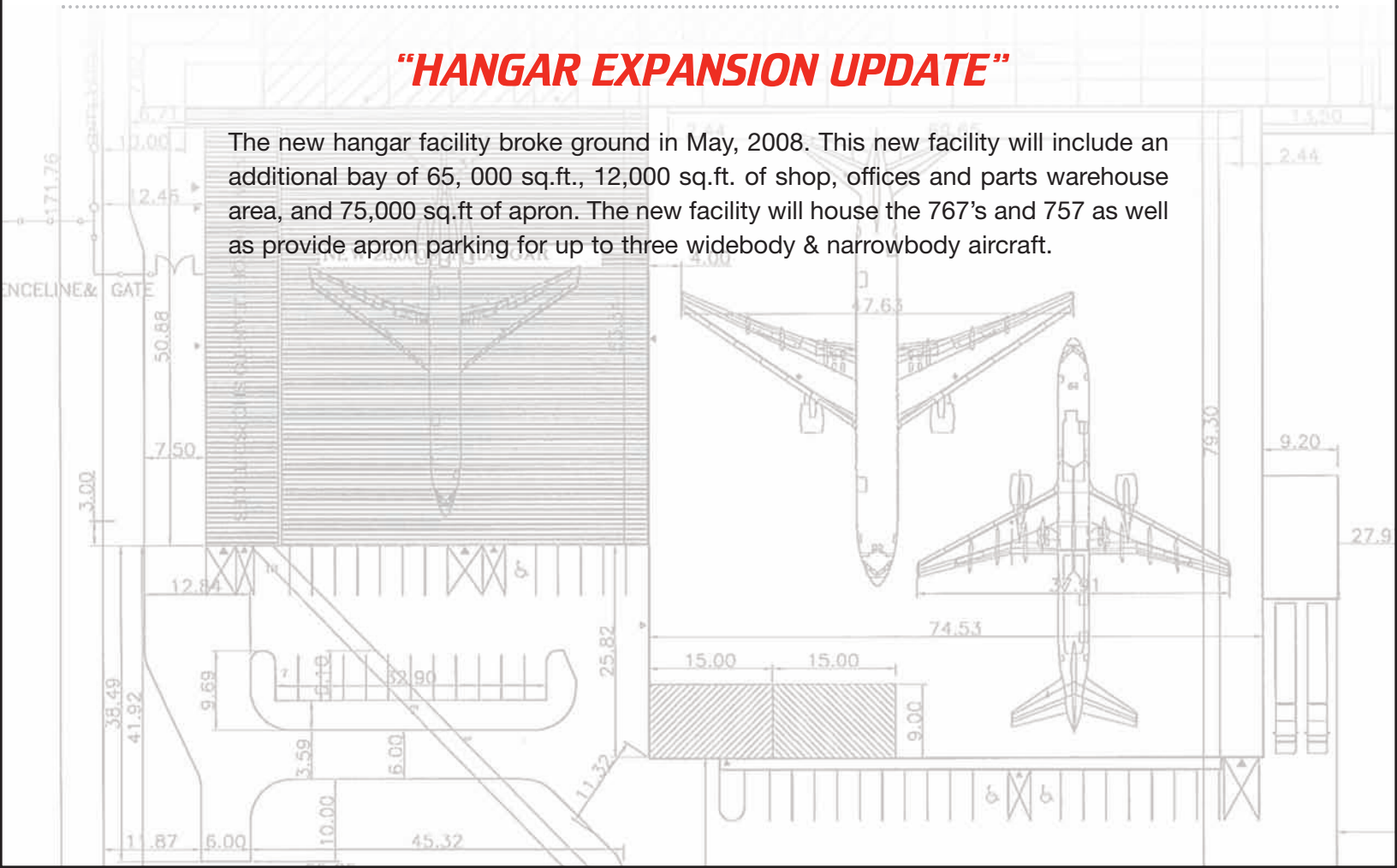
